DRD's Kevin Kalman wins Outstanding General Manager Award

Substantial contribution to recreation in the Coachella Valley recognized by California Association of Recreation and Park Districts

Indio, CA (June 1, 2017) – Desert Recreation District (DRD) is pleased to announce that the California Association of Recreation and Park Districts (CARPD) has awarded its Outstanding General Manager of the Year 2017 recognition to Kevin Kalman. Mr. Kalman has served DRD with commitment for nearly two decades in various roles including senior management, and then in 2011 he assumed the helm as General Manager.



During his 30-year career in Parks & Recreation, Mr. Kalman has made significant contributions to advance the interests of parks and recreation by improving the quality of life through a community collaborative approach. Under his leadership, Desert Recreation District's vision is to provide quality, barrier-free, and safe recreational activities that contribute to the overall wellness of the citizens of the Coachella Valley.

In the past few years, Mr. Kalman's accomplishments include finalizing negotiations with Riverside County in July 2015 whereby DRD assumed the management oversight of three new recreation facilities, which gave DRD the ability the expand service delivery in underserved areas; in that same month, Mr. Kalman's dedication to bringing much needed parks to remote and rural areas

of the eastern Coachella Valley was realized when DRD closed escrow on a 15-acre parcel of land. In September of 2016 the first phase of that dream became a reality as DRD opened a newly constructed temporary soccer park on 5 acres in the community of Oasis which gave the children a safe soccer field to play on, the first and only in this unincorporated community of Oasis.

Mr. Kalman continues to work locally alongside Assemblymember Eduardo Garcia, who was just recognized as State Legislator of the year, as well as in Sacramento to improve rural park funding for the benefit of the residents and visitors who enjoy the Coachella Valley.
