Indio, CA (September 10, 2015) – The First Tee of the Coachella Valley is holding a golf clinic for juniors with limited to no vision on Saturday, September 12, 2015 from 9 to 11 a.m. The clinic will consist of four rotations that include chipping, putting, pitching, and full swing practice. This is the first year Braille Institute Rancho Mirage and The First Tee of the Coachella Valley are working together to bring a golf clinic to approximately 10 to 12 youth with vision impairment.

Karla Corona, Youth Programs Director for Braille Institute Rancho Mirage noted they "are excited and thankful to the Joey Meyers Foundation for granting us the opportunity to work with The First Tee on this golf clinic. Our students are looking forward to it".

The First Tee provides young people with learning facilities and educational programs that promote character development and life-enhancing values through the game of golf. Dustin Smith, Program Director for The First Tee of the Coachella Valley, oversees the Volunteer program. The goal of The First Tee is to have the same number of volunteers as participants at Saturday's event so there can be one-on-one interaction and assistance between the volunteers and the golfers.
