Indio, CA (June 8, 2015) – The Desert Recreation District (DRD) is inviting residents and visitors to Get Your Fun On this summer. Recreational events are planned throughout the Coachella Valley to celebrate summer and beat the heat.

Summer Scene day camp is planned at the Indio Hills Community Center. Fun summer activities like arts and crafts will be included for kids ages 5 – 13. Sessions will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays from June 15 through August 5 from 1-4pm. The fee is \$1 per day per child.

Youth Indoor Soccer Clinic is being offered at the Indio Community Center. Children ages 7-14 years old will learn ball control, shooting & passing skills, proper footwork, conditioning and teamwork. Classes are held in two Sessions: Session 1 is June 15 – July 10. Session 2 is July 13 – August 7. Classes are Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Beginners class from 10:30 a.m. to Noon. Advanced class from Noon to 1:30pm.

Summer Basketball Camp This quality, motivational instruction for kids ages 5 to 14 is fun, yet competitive. Players are divided into age categories: 5 to 10 years old and 11 to 14 years old. Camp is held Indio Community Center, Tuesdays & Thursdays. Camps for 5 for 10 year olds are 10:30 a.m. to Noon; 11 to 14 year old players are 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. There are two sessions. Session 1: June 16 – July 9; Session 2 : July 14 – August 6.

Summer Camps in Indio, Palm Desert and Coachella will welcome new and returning campers. Kids ages 5 to 14 years old will be busy and active with sports, activities, creative arts, group games and more. There will be three sessions: Session 1: June 15 – July 2; Session 2: July 6 – 24; Session 3: July 27 – August 14.

Summer by the Shore & Summer Scene programs will be held in North Shore, Oasis and Thermal.
